

DIY: Hooking an Ipod to a Honda Civic Factory Radio

This is the first time I ever prepare one of these DIY so bear with me. Basically I wanted to hook up my Ipod to my Civic 2002 DX Coupe factory radio, but I didn't want to buy that expensive adapter that's on the internet. So I just tapped into the audio (L&R) signals that come from my CD player into the radio, thereby fooling the radio into playing the sound coming from my Ipod while a CD is playing. I was lucky that my CD player and the radio are two separate units in my Civic; otherwise I couldn't have done this, although I believe this same concept can be applied to a CD changer coming into the factory radio. I got his idea from two other DIY I found on the internet, which I can't seem to find now for some reason, well just so you know some people out there have already done it (I think one was on a Saab, the other on a Volkswagen.)
